#### 3. General Advisory

- 3.1. To ensure smooth registration, delegates are requested to submit completed forms, including scanned photos, passports, wherever applicable. Forms submitted with missing information, such as unclear passport copies, or any discrepancy in photo etc., will not be processed. For further information, please contact: rc-apac@isa.int
- 3.2. After 10 July 2025, any changes to existing registrations will only be possible through the 'Special Cases Cell'. Delegations are urged to ensure that such requests are limited to the absolute minimum only for unavoidable last-minute changes in the delegation composition.

### 4. Visa:

All visitors to Sri Lanka are required to possess a valid passport with a validity of at least 6 (six) months from the date of entry.

- 4.1. For the delegates from ISA Member or Signatory Countries that are LDCs and SIDS: The visa for two delegates, if required, will be sponsored and facilitated by the ISA Secretariat. Additional delegates nominated for participation are welcome to participate at their own cost. Countries can contact the ISA Secretariat via email id rc-apac@isa.int.
- 4.2. For the delegates from ISA Member or Signatory Countries that are not listed as LDCs and SIDS (<u>Annexure 1</u>): All arrangements with respect to visa may be made by the delegates themselves at their own cost. It is advisable to submit visa applications at the earliest to the relevant Sri Lankan Embassy.
- 4.3. For the delegates from ISA Prospective Countries including LDCs and SIDS:
  - a. The visa for the Hon'ble Minister from LDCs and SIDS, if required, will be sponsored and facilitated by the ISA Secretariat.
  - a. For other delegates holding diplomatic, official and ordinary passports: All arrangements with respect to visa may be made by the delegates themselves at their own cost. It is advisable to submit visa applications at the earliest to the relevant Sri Lankan Embassy.

# 5. Flight/ Airline Reservation

- 5.1. For the delegates from the ISA Member or Signatory Countries that are LDCs and SIDS: Round trip air tickets for two delegates will be sponsored for travelling for the Regional Committee Meeting. The delegates from the aforesaid countries are requested to coordinate with the ISA Secretariat for flight reservations at <u>rc-apac@isa.int</u>. The tickets will be communicated to the registered email ID. Additional delegates nominated by the aforesaid countries are welcome to participate at their own cost. Flight reservations will be made as under;
  - a. Business Class for the Hon'ble Minister,
  - b. Business Class for Secretary and Permanent Secretary level officials.
  - c. Economy Class for National Focal Points or any other designated delegate.
  - d. In case the Hon'ble Minister is not attending the Meeting, two designated delegates will be provided economy class tickets.
- 5.2. For the delegates from ISA Member or Signatory Countries that are not listed as LDCs and SIDS (<u>Annexure 1</u>): All arrangements with respect to flight reservations will be made by the delegates at their own cost.
- 5.3. For the delegates from ISA Prospective Countries of the ISA including LDCs and SIDS:
  - a. The flight reservations for the Hon'ble Minister from LDCs and SIDS will be sponsored and facilitated by the ISA Secretariat following provisions under **clause 5.1**.



b. For other delegates, all arrangements with respect to flight reservations will be made by the delegates themselves at their own cost.
