- **3. Cross-Border Startup Collaboration:** Fostering startup collaboration between innovators in solar and clean energy focusing on co-development, R&D partnerships, and market entry.
- **4.** The Role of Innovators in Accelerating Energy Access: Highlighting solutions being developed to bring clean, reliable electricity to all regions.
