BACKGROUND

The International Solar Alliance (ISA) launched the <u>SolarX Startup Challenge</u> to identify and support innovative, scalable, and cost-effective solutions to persistent challenges in the solar sectors of its member countries. Aiming to generate impact across technology, finance, and innovation, the Challenge strengthens the solar startup ecosystem while promoting entrepreneurship and local solutions. Following the success of its Africa and Asia-Pacific editions, ISA has launched the SolarX Startup Challenge 2025: Latin America & the Caribbean (LAC) Edition during COP 29. This edition targets the LAC region- rich in solar potential yet facing pressing energy access and sustainability challenges. Through this, ISA will support 20 winning startups with cash grants and acceleration support in the region. <u>Open for applications from 20 May 2025 to 15 August 2025</u>, the initiative underscores ISA's continued commitment to advancing solar deployment through regional innovation and inclusive energy transitions.

The SolaRX program has been a flagship of the ISA wherein 50 solar innovators are speaking with world class mentors to engage in technology transfer across the globe.

EXPECTED OUTCOME

- Enhanced awareness and visibility of the SolarX Startup Challenge 2025: LAC Edition across local innovation ecosystems.
- Increased number and quality of applications from eligible startups and innovators across the region.
- Improved understanding among participants about the objectives, eligibility, and benefits of the Challenge.
- Direct engagement between ISA, regional stakeholders, and aspiring solar entrepreneurs.
- Sharing of knowledge, best practices, and lessons learned from previous SolarX editions (Africa and Asia-Pacific).
